#### 6. 2010 Census Savannah Urbanized Area

Ms. Wykoda Wang gave a report on the 2010 census, that it will have an impact on the current MPO boundaries and funding. The new census would have Richmond Hill in Bryan County and a little of Effingham County included in our MPO boundary. The staff is still working on determining definite boundaries. The MPO is to include urbanized areas plus any area that is expected to be urbanized within the next twenty years. This analysis is underway by the MPO staff. Once this is determined, changes in the MPO membership could be made and a Memorandum of Understanding with GDOT will be issued.

Ms. Wang explained that part of Hunter Army Airfield, part of the airport, part of Bloomingdale and Pooler, and part of the Crossroads business center are not included in the Savannah urbanized area. The MPO has sent a letter questioning this decision.

Ms. Kaycee Mertz, of GDOT Planning, said that a letter is coming to the MPO regarding urban area boundaries with repect to the determination of functional classification for roadways.

Mr. Mark Willkes asked Ms. Mertz whether GDOT had spatial information for Effingham County and Bryan County at a smaller scale than what the MPO has so far, so the MPO can better incorporate the new area into the travel demand model. She said she would check.

7. Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21) -- the Congressional Surface Transportation Authorization

Ms. Jane Love presented the staff report. She stated that MAP-21 replaces SAFETEA-LU. MAP-21 continues current funding levels, with adjustments for inflation. Authorizations for FY 2013 and FY 2014 total \$ 105 billion. It reestablishes solvency of the Highway Trust Fund in the short-term with transfers from the General Fund and from the Leaking Underground Storgae Tank fund, to supplement the usual federal fuel tax revenue. However the Highway Trust Fund will be in the negative again in FY 2015. MAP-21 includes no earmarks, which is unlike previous authorizations.

Ms. Love also reviewed details under topics of consolidation of programs, metropolitan planning; and environmental streamlining, as outlined in the staff report provided prior to the meeting.
