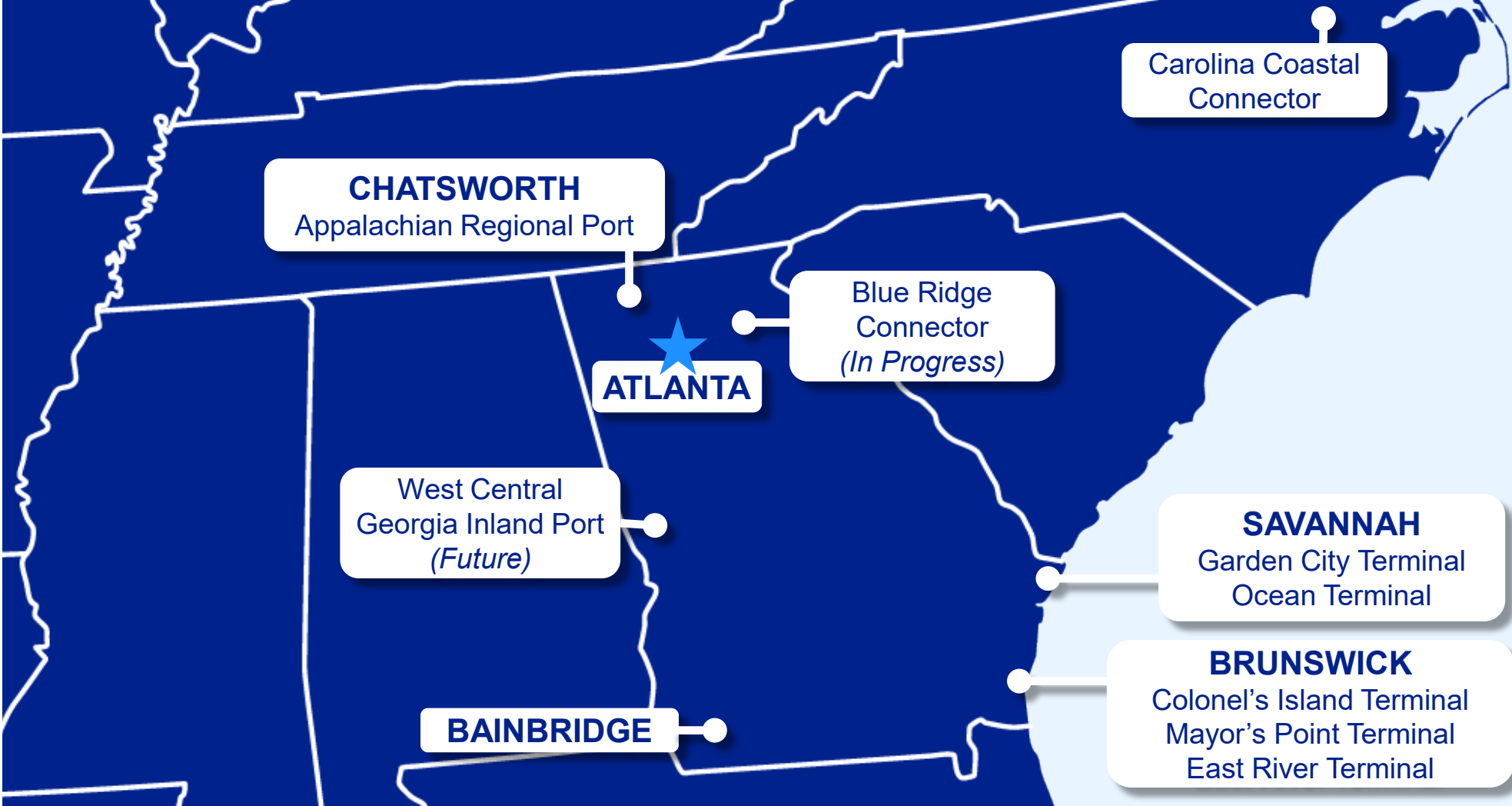

Rail reduces CO_{2e} by 74% or more

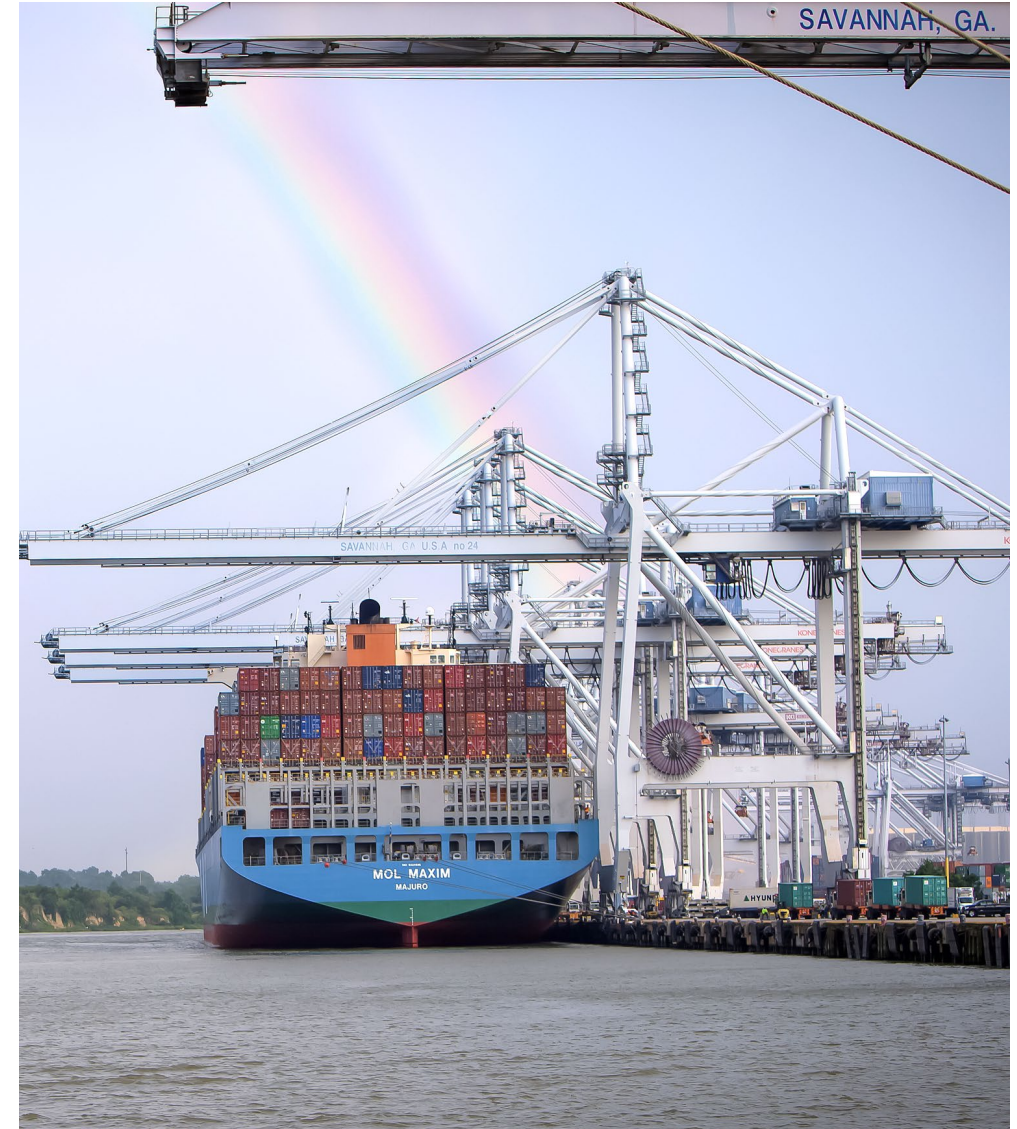

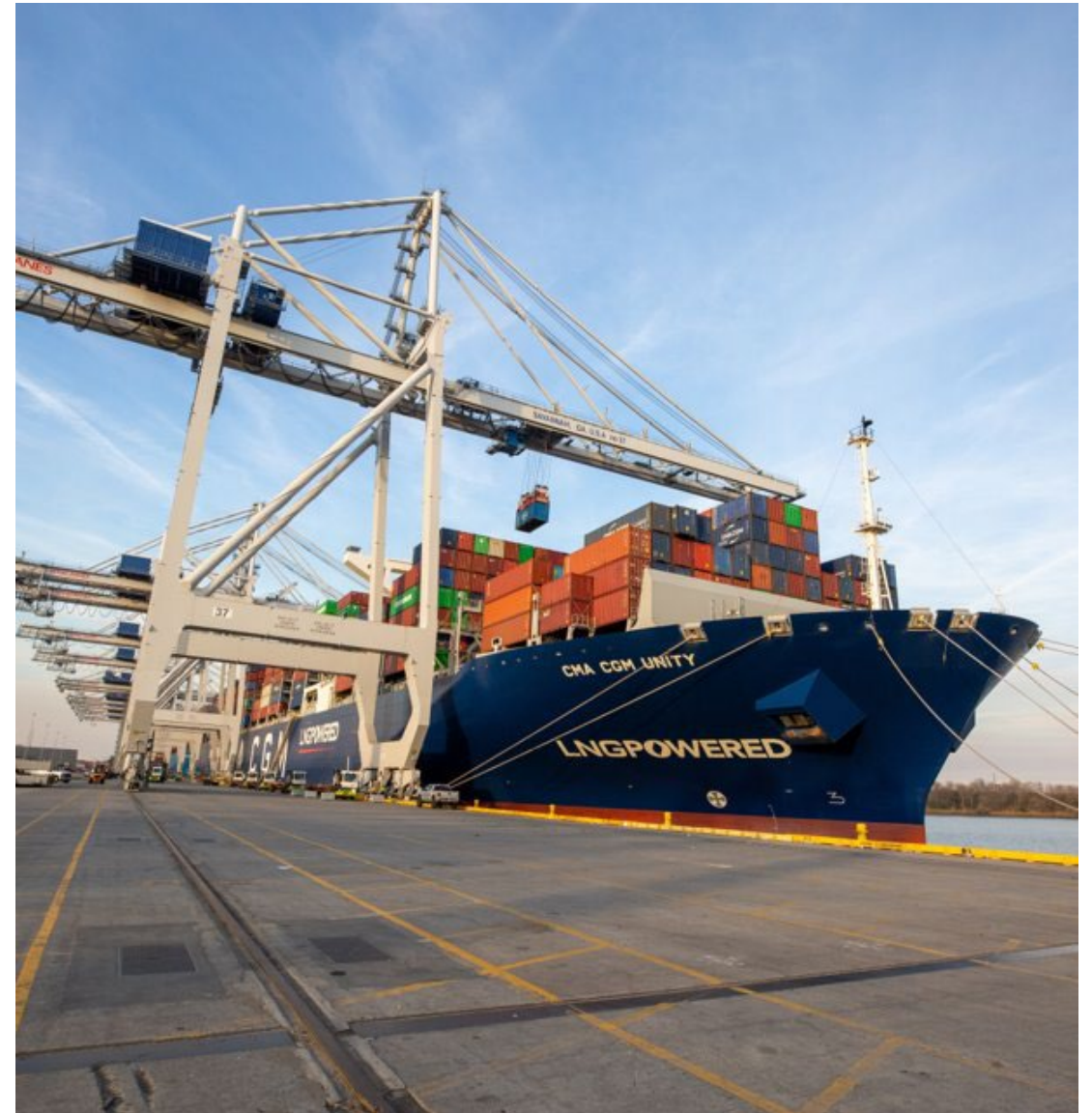
