### 2017 CALL FOR PROJECTS

The Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization (CORE MPO) is conducting a competitive project selection process to award Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) Program Urban Attributable (Z230) funds, provided through the act entitled Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (also known as FAST Act).

- Expected Available Funds = \$13 million (federal portion)
- Maximum Award = N/A
- Minimum Award = \$200,000 (federal portion)
- At least 20% of the eligible costs of the proposed project must be locally funded. (Previously incurred costs cannot be counted as part of the 20% match for the newly awarded federal funds.)

An applicant may request for *at least \$200,000 of federal funds*. The federal funding request in this application can represent no more than 80% of the total cost of the applicant's proposal. For example, if an applicant requests \$1,000,000, and provides no more than the required 20% local match, he/she would be submitting a proposal totaling \$1,250,000.

#### • Federal Requirements

Applicants should keep in mind that using the STBG funds involves adherence to federal requirements, as applicable, such as the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), prevailing wage rates (Davis-Bacon), Buy America, competitive bidding, and other contracting requirements, regardless of whether the projects are located within the right-of-way of a Federal-aid highway.

• Projects funded through this selection process must be located within the CORE MPO's Metropolitan Planning Area (MPA) boundary.

The CORE MPO administered STBG Urban Attributable funds can only be spent within the MPO's Metropolitan Planning Area which includes all of Chatham County, the portion of Effingham County and Bryan County located within the Savannah Urbanized Area, as well as Richmond Hill.

• Projects, if awarded funds, will be programmed in the CORE MPO's FY 2018 – 2021 Transportation Improvement Program (July 1, 2017 – June 30, 2021).

Once the project is programmed in the TIP and the awarded federal funding is authorized in a certain federal fiscal year, the funds must be obligated within two years, otherwise the funds will be rescinded for use by other selected priority projects.

**Proposal Description Summary** 

The proposed project will replace the existing, deteriorated bascule bridges on Island's Expressway over the Wilmington River with two fixed span structures having a minimum vertical clearance of 65-ft. The existing bridges are opened and closed approximately 4,000 times per year, causing significant traffic delay to the nearly 25,000 vehicles that utilize Island's Expressway. In addition, Island's Expressway is a critical hurricane evacuation route for island residents. Replacement of the existing structures will ensure a safe and efficient evacuation from the Island's without the worry of the current bascule bridges malfunctioning.

The requested Z230 funds will be used to help pay for the City of Savannah and Chatham County's water and sewer relocations associated with the project.

Island's Expressway provides two parallel bascule bridges over the Wilmington River at Causton Bluff just east of the City of Savannah in Chatham County. Island's Expressway is a four-lane rural highway with grassed medians and is classified as an Urban Principal Arterial. The eastbound bridge was constructed in 1963 and provides two 12-ft lanes. The westbound bridge was relocated from US 80 over the Wilmington River in 1989 and also provides two 12-ft travel lanes. The existing bridges do not have any shoulders or pedestrian facilities. The bridges cross the Wilmington River, which is part of the Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway. The existing bridges have a vertical clearance of 22.3-ft. Islands Expressway is a designated school bus route and is one of two major hurricane evacuation routes for the east island residents according to current FEMA, GEMA and CEMA evacuation plan maps.

The proposed project will replace the existing bascule bridges with two fixed span structures with a minimum vertical clearance of 65-ft. The existing bridges are structurally deficient, functionally obsolete and regularly have to be closed for emergency repairs to keep them in operation. The bridges open and close approximately 4,000 times per year causing significant traffic delays for the nearly 23,000 vehicles that utilize Islands Expressway on a daily basis. The proposed project will increase the vertical clearance of the crossing and eliminate traffic delay and associated lost travel time due to frequent bridge openings.

The maintenance and operation of the bascule bridges are a substantial burden to Chatham County. The annual operating and routine maintenance costs for these bridges represents approximately 60% of the County's annual bridge budget. The average annual maintenance and operation cost for the County over the past four years was approximately \$354,000. The current bridges only provide 100-ft of horizontal clearance for passing vessels, making it difficult for barges and larger boats to pass the bridge. The fender system shows signs of regular collisions with these boats and barges. The new bridge will provide approximately 195-ft of horizontal clearance.

The proposed bridges will also provide 10-ft wide outside shoulders with 6.5-ft paved for pedestrian and bicycle traffic. Replacement of the existing structures will improve safety, significantly reduce delay to vehicles on Island's Expressway and vessels in the Wilmington River, significantly reduce the County's operation and maintenance budget for these structures, will provide bicycle and pedestrian improvements and will improve the transportation reliability of the corridor. A NEPA document was approved in 2015 that showed no adverse environmental impacts associated with the project. Chatham County contributed funding for the PE, ROW, and UTL phases of the project. GDOT is funding CST. The project will promote tourism by providing a safe, reliable means for tourists to travel between the City of Savannah and Tybee Island.




