Amendments to FY 2024 – 2027 Transportation Improvement Program August 2024

Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is the MPO's short-range programming document and is a staged, multi-year listing of surface transportation projects proposed for federal, state, and local funding within the metropolitan area. The TIP may be modified in accordance with the procedures outlined in the adopted Participation Plan by resolution of the CORE MPO Board if priorities, area goals, project schedules or funding levels change.

The current FY 2024 – 2027 TIP was adopted by the CORE MPO Board on November 1, 2023 and is referenced in the Statewide TIP (STIP). It is important to make sure that the information contained in the TIP is current and reflective of the most up-to-date cost estimates and development schedules. CORE MPO staff has coordinated with the project managers/sponsors on projects' development status. It is also important to amend the TIP to add new or delete existing projects/phases at the request of sponsoring agencies based on the project changes and MTP/TIP consistencies.

AMENDMENT PROCESS FOR FY 2024 - FY 2027

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) must be consistent with the 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) called Moving Forward Together 2050 Plan, which was adopted on August 15, 2024. Before any amendments can be made to the FY 2024 - 2027 TIP, MTP/TIP consistency must be verified. The TIP must also be conformant to the Performance Based Planning and Programming (PBPP).

Projects/Phases requiring amendments, as opposed to administrative modification, to the TIP require a 15-day public review and comment period.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

The adopted TIP/STIP amendment process outlined in the CORE MPO's Participation Plan requires public review and comment and responses to all comments (either individually or in summary form) for all TIP amendments. To process the amendments in August 2024, CORE MPO advertised a fifteen (15) day public comment period in the Savannah Morning News on Sunday, July 21, 2024 (Appendix B). The notice was sent to the local news media and the consultation agencies as well as neighborhood associations and posted on the CORE MPO website. The comment period started on July 24, 2024 and closed on August 15, 2024. Due to Hurricane Debby, the CORE MPO Board meeting was rescheduled to August 15th and the

comment period was extended. No written comments on the proposed TIP amendments have been received. Verbal comments have been addressed on the floor at the August CORE MPO Board and advisory committee meetings.

CORE MPO Actions

The proposed amendments to the FY 2024 - 2027 TIP were endorsed by the CORE MPO Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) on August 1, 2024. The CORE MPO Board approved the TIP amendments on August 15, 2024.

This bridge consists of 7 reinforced concrete deck girder spans, on precast concrete piles supporting concrete caps. The bridge was designed for an H 15 vehicle. This bridge is posted for load restriction due to insufficient shear capacity of the concrete superstructure. This bridge is also scour critical. In addition, cracking and scaling is present in the deck with several pop outs and exposed rebar. The beams have minor deflection cracking and one spall with exposed rebar. Erosion is present under each abutment. Spalls are present in several caps with exposed rebar. Due to the condition of this bridge, load restriction, and being scour critical, replacement is necessary.
