

Amendments to FY 2024 – 2027 Transportation Improvement Program

February 2024

Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is the MPO's short-range programming document and is a staged, multi-year listing of surface transportation projects proposed for federal, state, and local funding within the metropolitan area. The TIP may be modified in accordance with the procedures outlined in the adopted Participation Plan by resolution of the CORE MPO Board if priorities, area goals, project schedules or funding levels change.

The current FY 2024 – 2027 TIP was adopted by the CORE MPO Board on November 1, 2023 and is referenced in the Statewide TIP (STIP). It is important to make sure that the information contained in the TIP is current and reflective of the most up-to-date cost estimates and development schedules. CORE MPO staff has coordinated with the project managers/sponsors on projects' development status. It is also important to amend the TIP to add new or delete existing projects/phases at the request of sponsoring agencies based on the project changes and MTP/TIP consistencies.

In January 2024, the City of Savannah requested a TIP amendment be made to Truman Linear Park Trail Phase II-B. The following summary outlines the proposed changes to the FY 2024 – 2027 TIP.

AMENDMENT PROCESS FOR FY 2024 - FY 2027 TIP

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) must be consistent with the current 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) called Mobility 2045. Before any amendments can be made to the FY 2024 - 2027 TIP, MTP/TIP consistency must be verified. The TIP must also be conformant to the Performance Based Planning and Programming (PBPP).

Projects/Phases requiring amendments, as opposed to administrative modification, to the TIP require a 15-day public review and comment period.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

The adopted TIP/STIP amendment process outlined in the CORE MPO's Participation Plan requires public review and comment and responses to all comments (either individually or in summary form) for all TIP amendments. To process the proposed amendments in February 2024, CORE MPO advertised a fifteen (15) day public comment period in the Savannah Morning News on Sunday, February 11, 2024 (Appendix B). The notice was sent to the local news media and the consultation agencies as well as neighborhood associations and posted on the CORE MPO website. The comment period started on February 14, 2024 and closed on February 28, 2024. A public hearing was advertised, and it was held in conjunction with the CORE MPO Board meeting on February 28, 2024. No written comments have been received. Verbal comments and questions were addressed on the floor.

CORE MPO Action

The proposed amendments to the FY 2024 – 2027 TIP were endorsed by the CORE MPO Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) and Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) on February 15, 2024 and by the Advisory Committee on Accessible Transportation (ACAT) on February 26, 2024. The CORE MPO Board approved the TIP amendments on February 28, 2024.

Project Description:	The Truman Linear Park Trail is the demonstration project for initial implementation under the Coastal Georgia Greenway Master Plan. Phase I trail construction is completed. Phase II is proposed as a development of a multiuse trail from Phase I at 52nd Street and Bee Road to Lake Mayer Community Park. Phase II-A (from Lake Mayer to DeRenne) is completed an opened to the public. Phase II-B will complete the multiuse trail from DeRenne Avenue to 52nd Street/Bee Road, to be implemented by the City of Savannah. *ADA compliant trail.		
Project Status:	The construction (CST) phase was programmed in the previous FY 2021 – 2024 TIP. In late May/early June 2023, the CST funds (earmark and Y972) were authorized based on the cost estimates provided by the City of Savannah at that time in the amount of \$3,884,522.5. Since then, the City has completed the bidding process and received three bids. The lowest bid is \$7,821,105.60 (\$7,448,672 base bid + 5% contingency cost of \$372,433.6). The City decided to use the 10% contingency cost to the base bid in the construction contract, making the total bid amount to \$8,193,540. The City Council accepted the bid on February 8, 2024. The City staff approached the CORE MPO staff to request assistance in additional funding. CORE MPO coordinated with GDOT and determined that a new CST phase needs to be programmed in the current FY 2024 – 2027 TIP before any additional federal funds can be allocated to the project. The current TIP had small balances in FY 2024 from the Carbon Reduction Program (Y601) and the STBG program (Y230). The City of Savannah needs to come up with the majority of the needed additional funds.

Reason for Update:	The project needs additional funds to cover the additional cost needed for construction.		
PBPP:	The project will help achieve the performance targets for Safety and Air Quality.


