Agenda Item: City of Pooler SR 26 From Chatham County line to SR 21

Summary: The Coastal Region Metropolitan Planning Organization (CORE MPO)

received more than \$2 million of CRSSAA funds in late 2021. CORE MPO completed a project selection process through a Call for Projects for these funds. \$285,000 of the funds have been awarded to conduct the SR 26 from Chatham County Line to SR 21 study (PI # 0018344). No local match is

required for CRSSAA funds.

The City of Pooler is the project manager and will coordinate with the City of Garden City, the City of Bloomingdale, the City of Savannah, Unincorporated

Chatham County as well as CORE MPO to conduct the study.

After receiving 4 bids from Lumin8, Croy Engineering, Kimley Horn, and Keck Wood, the review team went over the proposals, and the scoring is complete. Pooler is currently negotiating scope and fee with the highest ranked

consultant, Kimley Horn.

A PFA between GDOT and Pooler is circulating currently. A letter was drafted by Pooler for a Notice of Award to the highest ranked consultant and a scoping meeting will be set up soon.

It is intended to present the recommendation for award to the Pooler Mayor and Council at their June 21st meeting.
